

MIDDLE NENE ARCHAEOLOGICAL GROUP

CONSTITUTION

- 1 The Group shall be known as the MIDDLE NENE ARCHAEOLOGICAL GROUP.
- 2 The aims of the Group shall be to undertake and encourage interest in archaeological fieldwork in the Middle Nene Valley. The Group shall seek to train its members in the techniques of excavation and fieldwork, the recording of known, and discovery of new archaeological sites.
- 3 The Group shall be open to all.
- 4 Honorary members may from time to time be elected, such elections to be approved at an Annual General Meeting.
- 5 Subscription rates shall be reviewed by the Committee from time to time.
- 6 The Committee shall consist of : the President, Vice-President, Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer and such ordinary members of the Group as the Committee shall from time to time co-opt.
- 7 With the exception of the President and Vice-President, election of officers shall take place at the Annual General Meeting. Nominations must be received by the Secretary not less than fourteen days before the date of the Annual General Meeting.
- 8 The Chairman shall preside at meetings of the Group and at meetings of the Committee and shall have a casting vote.
- 9 In the absence of the Chairman, the President, Vice-president or Secretary may preside at meetings of the Group and at Committee meetings
- 10 The Secretary shall be responsible for all arrangements concerning the activities of the Group, excepting such as come under the duties of the Treasurer.
- 11 The Treasure shall be responsible for the receipt of all subscriptions, donations and proceeds of events and for all payments in connection with the activities of the Group
- 12 The Treasurer may (with consent) represent the Group in any legal proceedings and shall be indemnified out of the assets of the Group, against any liabilities incurred in consequence.
- 13 The Committee shall meet at least once a year and shall consider all questions relevant to the running of the Group. A quorum of 50% of Committee members must be present before a meeting can take place.
